

Public Notice:

Consistent with Texas Local Government Code Chapter 43, The City of Honey Grove, Texas proposes to Annex land generally described as 49.468 acres from the Marcus Brinkley Survey and Andrew Daugherty Survey located about 18.32 miles North and East of the City of Bonham, Fannin County, Texas, to enlarge and extend the boundary limits of Honey Grove, Texas.

The Honey Grove City Council will hold public hearings on a voluntary annexation petition on the following dates:
