

Filing Begins for Honey Grove May 5' 2018 City Election

The City will be accepting applications for 1 (One) Mayor and 2 (two) Alderman, each for two-year terms, for the May 5th 2018 City Election. Qualifications to file for City Mayor show you must live in the State of Texas for one year prior to filing deadline and one year in the City of Honey Grove prior to Election Day. Qualifications to file for a City Alderman show you must live in the State of Texas for one year prior to filing deadline and in the City of Honey Grove for six months prior to the filing deadline. Other requirements are that you must be 18 years of age or older, you must be a registered voter of the City at the time of the Election and you must not be in arrears in the payment of any taxes or liability due to the City of Honey Grove.

DATES TO REMEMBER:

January 1 - First day to apply for Ballot by Mail

January 17 – February 16 - Filing for place on ballot

February 20 - Drawing for places on the ballot
(10:00 a.m. in the City Secretary's Office)

April 5 - Deadline to Register to Vote

April 23 - First day of Early Voting

April 24 - Last day to apply for ballot by mail

May 1 - Last day of early Voting

May 5 - City Election (7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.)
